House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3045

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Dental
7	Examiners, for the support of said board for the fiscal year
8	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007

10	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
11	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be

30 For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee 31 who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an 32 33 amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on 34 July 1, 2006. 35 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 36 37 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 38 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 39 40 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 41 42 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 43 44 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 45 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 46 47 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 48 49 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 50 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 51 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 52 53 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 54 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 55 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 56 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 57 58 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 59 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 60 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 61 The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 62

approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

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- 64 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 65 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 67 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 68 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 69 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 70 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that none
- 71 of the funds appropriated in this act shall be authorized for the
- 72 purchase of surveillance equipment.
- 73 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 74 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 75 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 76 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 77 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 78 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 79 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 80 made without competitive bids.
- 81 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 82 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 83 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 84 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 85 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 86 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 87 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 88 and after July 1, 2006.
