House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3048

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

S. B. 3048 PAGE 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Board of Registered
8	Professional Geologists for the purpose of defraying the expenses
9	of the Board, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and
LO	ending June 30, 2007\$ 138,564.00.
L1	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
L2	of this act, the following positions are authorized and shall be
L3	under the authority of the State Personnel Board:
L4	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
L5	Permanent: Full Time 1
L6	Part Time 0
L7	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
L8	Part Time 0
L9	For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are
20	provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee
21	who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an
22	amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on
23	July 1, 2006.
24	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
25	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
26	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
27	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
28	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
29	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
30	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the

- 31 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- 32 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
- 33 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- 34 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 35 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 36 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
- 37 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 38 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 39 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 40 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 41 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
- 42 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 43 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 44 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 45 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 47 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 48 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 49 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 50 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 51 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 52 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 53 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 54 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 56 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 57 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 58 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 59 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 60 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 61 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 62 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 63 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 64 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

- the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 65 66 made without competitive bids.
- 67 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 68 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 69 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 70 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 71 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 73 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 74 and after July 1, 2006.
