House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3050

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
6	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
7	State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Motor Vehicle
8	Commission, as provided by Section 63-17-51 et seq., Mississippi
9	Code of 1972, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of said
10	Commission, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending
11	June 30, 2007\$ 281,372.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

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For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on July 1, 2006.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 37 38 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 39 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 40 41 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 42 43 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 44 45 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 46 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 47 act. 48 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 49 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 50 51 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 52 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 53 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 54 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 55 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 56 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 57 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 58

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

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66 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 67 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

72 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 73 of the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act shall 74 be expended to defray any expenses of the Motor Vehicle Commission 75 if said commission takes any official actions during Fiscal Year 76 2007 that serve directly or indirectly to reduce the payment to 77 the State General Fund of any sales tax on motor vehicles sold 78 within the State of Mississippi.

79 It is further the intention of the Legislature that if such 80 actions are taken by the Motor Vehicle Commission during Fiscal 81 Year 2007, the executive director and commission members shall be held personally liable for repayment of any funds expended under 82 83 the provisions of this act with said repayment to be made to the 84 State General Fund. The Attorney General is hereby authorized and 85 directed to undertake appropriate legal action to enforce the 86 provisions of this act and to recover said funds.

87 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 88 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 89 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 90 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 91 92 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 93 94 made without competitive bids.

95 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 96 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 97 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 98 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 99 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 100 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 101 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 102 and after July 1, 2006.
