House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3055

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State

12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be

31 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: Permanent: 32 Full Time..... 41 33 Part Time..... 1 Full Time..... 34 Time-Limited: 35 Part Time..... For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are 36 provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee 37 38 who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an 39 amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on 40 July 1, 2006. 41 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 42 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 43 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 44 45 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 46 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 47 48 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 49 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 50 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 51 52 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 53 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 54 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 55 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 56 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 57 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 58 59 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 60 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 61 62 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 63 64 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 65 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State

- 66 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 67 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 68
- 69 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 70 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 71 appropriated level.
- 72 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 73 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 74 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 75
- 76 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 77 Office of State Aid Road Construction shall maintain complete
- 78 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 79 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 80
- 81 It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be 82
- 83 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 84 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 85
- 86 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 87 Office of State Aid Road Construction shall have the authority to
- 88 accept, budget and expend funds, comprised of special funds to the
- 89 office, not to exceed Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00)
- 90 for the purpose of replacement of structurally deficient bridges
- 91 on the state's county roads. Such funds are to be escalated in
- accordance with procedures for federal fund escalations as 92
- established in Section 27-104-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, and 93
- 94 expended for the purposes of performing such duties as set forth
- 95 by law in accordance with applicable rules and regulations of the
- State Fiscal Officer. 96
- 97 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this
- act, the Office of State Aid Road Construction is authorized to 98
- reimburse Adams County in the amount of Five Hundred Thousand 99
- 100 Dollars (\$500,000.00) from unobligated State Aid Road funds

allocated to Adams County for the 2004 - 2007 term of office of 101

102 members of the board of supervisors to match federal aid funds of

the Surface Transportation Program administered by the Mississippi 103

104 Department of Transportation for the project known as Government

105 Fleet Road Extension that is designated as the Intermodal

106 Connector Route 83, Adams County, Mississippi.

107 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that none

108 of the funds appropriated above shall be expended unless members

109 of the Mississippi Senate and House of Representatives are

notified at least five (5) days prior to a public ceremony 110

111 announcing the award of any grant in their district or any public

112 announcement or ceremony regarding the groundbreaking or opening

113 of a facility, roadway or bridge for which the Legislature has

made funds available. Any signage regarding any public event or 114

115 any new facility, roadway or bridge shall include the following

116 language: "Funds were made available for this project by the

117 Mississippi State Legislature."

118 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the

119 Office of State Aid Road Construction may accept, budget and

expend funds not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Dollars 120

121 (\$300,000.00) out of funds received from the Mississippi

122 Development Authority as reimbursement for actual expenses

123 incurred by the Office of State Aid Road Construction for

124 administering and providing engineering services to political

125 subdivisions as authorized under Section 65-4-15, Mississippi Code

of 1972, subject to and in accordance with rules and regulations 126

of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner 127

consistent with the escalation of federal funds. Any escalated 128

129 funds shall be deposited into the Office of State Aid Roads

130 Administrative Fund, a special fund hereby created in the State

Treasury, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending 131

132 June 30, 2007.

SECTION 8. The office of State Aid Road Construction of the 133

134 Mississippi Department of Transportation shall be exempt from any

transfer of special funds into the State General Fund or the 135

136 Budget Contingency Fund created in Section 27-103-301, that is

137 directed or authorized by the Department of Finance and

138 Administration or by the State Treasurer.

139 **SECTION 9.** It is the intention of the Legislature that

140 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the

141 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

142 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

143 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

144 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

146 made without competitive bids.

147 **SECTION 10.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

153 **SECTION 11.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

154 and after July 1, 2006.
