15	(2) As used in this Section 3-3-15.1, the term "POW/MIA $$

18	101-355 (36 USCS 189).
19	(3) The Bureau of Capitol Facilities shall display the
20	POW/MIA flag in a prominent place at the New Capitol Building on

22	(a) Armed Forces Day, the third Saturday in May;

(4) Such display shall serve as the symbol of the nation's
and the state's concern and commitment to achieving the fullest
possible accounting of Americans and Mississippians who, having
been prisoners of war or missing in action, still remain
unaccounted for.

33 (5) This section shall not be construed or applied so as to
34 either require or prohibit the display of the POW/MIA flag by any
35 county, municipality or public school district in Mississippi.

36 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 37 and after its passage.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO CODIFY SECTION 3-3-15.1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO DIRECT THE BUREAU OF CAPITOL FACILITIES TO DISPLAY THE POW/MIA 3 FLAG AT THE NEW CAPITOL BUILDING ON CERTAIN DAYS RELATING TO THE 4 RECOGNITION OF VETERANS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
