COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

**Senate Bill No. 2432**

**BY: Committee**

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting  
in lieu thereof the following:**

6        SECTION 1. The following provision shall be codified as  
7 Section 3-3-15.1, Mississippi Code of 1972:

8        3-3-15.1. (1) In order to commemorate the 50th anniversary  
9 of the Korean Conflict, the Legislature enacts this Section  
10 3-3-15.1 as the symbol of the nation's and the state's commitment  
11 to achieving the fullest possible accounting for Mississippians  
12 who have been or in the future may become prisoners of war,  
13 missing in action or otherwise unaccounted for as a result of  
14 hostile action.

15        (2) As used in this Section 3-3-15.1, the term "POW/MIA  
16 Flag" means the National League of Families POW/MIA flag  
17 recognized officially and designated by Section 2 of Public Law  
18 101-355 (36 USCS 189).

19        (3) The Bureau of Capitol Facilities shall display the  
20 POW/MIA flag in a prominent place at the New Capitol Building on  
21 the following days:

- 22           (a) Armed Forces Day, the third Saturday in May;  
23           (b) Memorial Day, the last Monday in May;  
24           (c) Flag Day, June 14;

- 25           (d) Independence Day, July 4;  
26           (e) National POW/MIA Recognition Day; and  
27           (f) Veterans Day, November 11.

28           (4) Such display shall serve as the symbol of the nation's  
29 and the state's concern and commitment to achieving the fullest  
30 possible accounting of Americans and Mississippians who, having  
31 been prisoners of war or missing in action, still remain  
32 unaccounted for.

33           (5) This section shall not be construed or applied so as to  
34 either require or prohibit the display of the POW/MIA flag by any  
35 county, municipality or public school district in Mississippi.

36           **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
37 and after its passage.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and  
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

1           AN ACT TO CODIFY SECTION 3-3-15.1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,  
2 TO DIRECT THE BUREAU OF CAPITOL FACILITIES TO DISPLAY THE POW/MIA  
3 FLAG AT THE NEW CAPITOL BUILDING ON CERTAIN DAYS RELATING TO THE  
4 RECOGNITION OF VETERANS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
