## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Senate Bill No. 2915

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8 SECTION 1. Section 37-101-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9 amended as follows:

10 37-101-3. (1) The Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, shall appoint the members of the Board of 11 Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, one (1) member 12 from each congressional district of the state as existing as of 13 March 31, 1944, one (1) member from each Supreme Court district 14 and two (2) members from the state at large, with the terms of 15 each to begin on May 8, 1944. One-third (1/3) of the membership 16 17 of said board so appointed shall be appointed for a period of four 18 (4) years, one-third (1/3) for a period of eight (8) years and one-third (1/3) for a period of twelve (12) years. 19 On the 20 expiration of any of said terms of office the Governor shall 21 appoint successors, by and with the advice and consent of the 22 Senate, for terms of twelve (12) years in each case.

23 <u>The current president, or his/her designee, of the Student</u> 24 <u>Body President's Council of Mississippi (SBPCM) shall have a</u> 25 <u>reserved seat at each meeting of the Board of Trustees of State</u> 26 Institutions of Higher Learning. Not less than once a year, the

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## 27 board shall seek the advice and counsel of the student body

28 president's organization.

In case of a vacancy on said board by death or 29 (2) 30 resignation of a member or from any other cause than the 31 expiration of such member's term of office, the board shall elect 32 his successor who shall hold office until the end of the next 33 session of the Legislature. During such term of the session of 34 the Legislature the Governor shall appoint the successor member of the board from the district from which his predecessor was 35 appointed to hold office until the end of the period or term for 36 37 which said original trustee was appointed, to the end that one-third (1/3) of such trustees' terms shall expire each four (4)38 39 vears.

(3) The Executive Director of the State Board for Community 40 and Junior Colleges, or his designee, and one (1) member of the 41 State Board for Community and Junior Colleges to be designated by 42 the chairman of said board, shall attend all regular meetings of 43 44 the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning. Said community/junior college representatives shall have no 45 46 jurisdiction or vote on any matter within the jurisdiction of the The Executive Director of the State Board for Community 47 board. 48 and Junior Colleges and any designee who is a state employee shall receive no per diem for attending meetings of the board, but shall 49 50 be entitled to actual and necessary expense reimbursement and 51 mileage for attending meetings at locations other than Jackson, Mississippi. The designee of the State Board for Community and 52 53 Junior Colleges shall receive per diem compensation as authorized by Section 25-3-69, Mississippi Code of 1972, for attending said 54 55 meetings, and shall be entitled to reimbursement for actual expense reimbursement and mileage, which shall be paid from funds 56 57 appropriated to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of 58 Higher Learning.

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59 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 60 and after July 1, 2006.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-101-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO PROVIDE THAT THE CURRENT PRESIDENT OF THE UNIVERSITY STUDENT 3 BODY PRESIDENT'S COUNCIL SHALL HAVE A RESERVED SEAT AT MEETINGS OF 4 THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING AND 5 SHALL ADVISE THE BOARD ON AN ANNUAL BASIS; AND FOR RELATED 6 PURPOSES.
