## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

## 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Legislative findings.

5 In the spirit of the report of the Governor's Commission on б Recovery, Rebuilding and Renewal, the Legislature finds that there 7 is a need for consolidation of water, wastewater, storm water and solid waste services in order to reduce costs, promote resilience 8 9 in the event of disaster, improve the quality of the natural 10 environment, and improve the planning and delivery of quality water, wastewater, storm water and solid waste services within the 11 areas of the Counties of George, Hancock, Harrison, Jackson, Pearl 12 13 River and Stone. It is further declared that there is need for 14 the planning, acquisition, construction, maintenance, operation 15 and coordination of user-funded water, wastewater, storm water and solid waste systems in order to ensure protection of the waters of 16 17 the state and to ensure the delivery of water, wastewater, storm water and solid waste services to citizens of the Gulf Coast 18 19 Region. The creation of the Mississippi Gulf Region Utility Board 20 Act is determined to be necessary and essential to the 21 accomplishment of these purposes.
