No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

80 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 81 82 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 83 84 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 85 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 86 87 made without competitive bids.

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88 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 89 90 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 91 92 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 93 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 94 95 and after July 1, 2006.
