## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

## Senate Bill No. 3042

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Architecture and
8	Landscape Architecture Advisory Committee, for the purpose of
9	defraying the expenses incurred by said board for the fiscal year
10	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
11	\$ 276,093.00.
12	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
13	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
15	Permanent: Full Time 2
16	Part Time 0
17	Time-Limited: Full Time
18	Part Time 0
19	For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are
20	provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee
21	who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an
22	amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on
23	July 1, 2006.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 24 25 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 26 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 27 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 28 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 29 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 30 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 31 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 32 33 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 34 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 35 36 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 37 38 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 39 40 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 41 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 42 43 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 44 45 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 46 47 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 48 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 49 50 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 51 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 52 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 53 54 appropriated level.

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 59 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 60 Board of Architecture shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 61 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 62 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 63 It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 64 65 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 66 67 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 69 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 70 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 71 72 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 73 74 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 75 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 76 made without competitive bids.

77 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 78 79 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 80 81 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 82 83 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 84 and after July 1, 2006.

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
