Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
6	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
7	State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Banking
8	and Consumer Finance, for the support of the State Department of
9	Banking and Consumer Finance, for the fiscal year beginning
10	July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
11	\$ 4,757,313.00.
12	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
13	of Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
15	expenditure:

36	For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are
37	provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee
38	who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an
39	amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on
40	July 1, 2006.
41	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
42	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
43	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
44	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
45	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
46	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
47	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
48	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
49	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
50	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
51	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
52	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
53	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
54	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
55	If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal

- 56 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 57 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 58 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
- 59 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 60 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 61 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 62 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 64 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 65 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 66 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 67 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 68 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 69 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 70 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 71 appropriated level.
- 72 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 73 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 74 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 75 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 76 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 77 Banking and Consumer Finance shall maintain complete accounting
- 78 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 79 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 80 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 81 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 82 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to
- 83 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 84 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 85 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.
- 86 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 87 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the

- 88 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 89 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 90 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 91 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 92 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 93 made without competitive bids.
- 94 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 95 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 96 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 97 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 98 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 99 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 100 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 101 and after July 1, 2006.
