Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Senate Bill No. 3047

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Funeral Services for
8	the purpose of defraying the expenses of said board for the fiscal
9	year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
10	\$ 230,722.00.
11	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
12	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
13	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
14	Permanent: Full Time 2
15	Part Time0
16	Time-Limited: Full Time 0
17	Part Time0
18	For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are
19	provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee
20	who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an
21	amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on
22	July 1, 2006.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 23 24 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 25 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 26 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 27 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 28 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 29 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 30 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 31 32 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 33 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 34 35 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 36 37 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 38 39 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 40 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 41 42 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 43 44 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 45 46 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 47 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 48 49 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 50 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 51 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 52 53 appropriated level.

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 57 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 58 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 59 Funeral Services Board shall maintain complete accounting and
- 60 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 61 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 62 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 63 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 64 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to
- 65 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 66 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 67 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.
- 68 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 69 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 70 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 71 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 72 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 73 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 74 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 75 made without competitive bids.
- 76 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 77 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 78 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 79 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 80 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 81 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 82 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 83 and after July 1, 2006.
