For the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2006, funds are provided herein to adjust the annual compensation of each employee who has been employed for twelve (12) months or longer by an amount equal to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), effective on July 1, 2006.

36 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 37 38 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 39 40 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 41 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 42 43 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 44 45 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 46 act. 47 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 48 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 49 50 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 51 52 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 53 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 54 55 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation

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56 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 57 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

58 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 59 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 60 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 61 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 62 The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 63 64 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 65 66 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

71 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that 72 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 73 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 74 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 75 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 76 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 77 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids. 78

79 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 80 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 81 82 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 83 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 84 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 85 86 and after July 1, 2006.

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
