Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 308

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 6 Section 37-43-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- (1) This chapter is intended to furnish a plan for 8 37-43-1.
- 9 the adoption, purchase, distribution, care and use of free
- textbooks to be loaned to the pupils in all elementary and high 10
- 11 schools of Mississippi.
- 12 (2) The books herein provided by the State Board of
- Education, which shall be the State Textbook Procurement 13
- 14 Commission, shall be distributed and loaned free of cost to the
- 15 children of the free public schools of the state and of all other
- schools located in the state, which maintain educational standards 16
- 17 equivalent to the standards established by the State Department of
- 18 Education for the state schools as outlined in the Approval
- Requirements of the State Board of Education for Nonpublic 19
- 20 Schools.
- 21 Teachers shall permit all pupils in all grades of any
- public school to carry to their homes for home study, the free 22
- 23 textbooks loaned to them, and any other regular textbooks whether
- they be free textbooks or not. 24
- 25 (4) For the purposes of this chapter, the term "board" shall
- mean the State Board of Education. 26
- Textbook shall be defined as any medium or manual of 27
- 28 instruction which contains a systematic presentation of the
- principles of a subject and which constitutes a major 29
- 30 instructional vehicle for that subject.

- 32 local school boards shall make available to the parents or legal
- 33 guardians of homeschooled students or students attending any other
- 34 private school, Boys and Girls Clubs, after school programs or any
- 35 other schools, who reside in the school district administered by
- 36 the school board, upon request, any textbooks on the state surplus
- 37 inventory list that will assist in the homeschool instructional
- 38 program. The parent or legal guardian is responsible for the
- 39 return of the textbook(s) to the local school district upon
- 40 completion of the textbook(s) use as part of the homeschool
- 41 instructional program. Failure to return the textbook(s) to the
- 42 school district will result in the parents or legal guardians
- 43 being responsible for compensating the school district for the
- 44 fair market value of the textbook(s). This subsection shall stand
- 45 repealed from and after July 1, 2008.
- 46 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 47 and after July 1, 2006.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-43-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE LOCAL SCHOOL BOARDS TO MAKE AVAILABLE SURPLUS TEXTBOOKS TO THE PARENTS OR LEGAL GUARDIANS OF HOMESCHOOLED STUDENTS OR OTHER

PRIVATE OR PUBLIC SCHOOLS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
