Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1009

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 99-19-45, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 99-19-45. The clerks of the circuit court of the counties in
- 10 the State of Mississippi shall furnish the Mississippi Department
- 11 of Corrections, within five (5) days after adjournment of court, a
- 12 commitment paper showing the name, sex, race and social security
- 13 number of the person convicted * * * and * * * the crime
- 14 committed, along with certified copies of the sentencing order and
- 15 indictment, as well as any subsequent order entered by the court
- 16 in such cause.
- 17 The clerks shall also furnish the Department of Corrections,
- 18 within five (5) days after adjournment of such court, a certified
- 19 copy of the probation order of an individual who is placed on
- 20 probation under the supervision of the Division of Community
- 21 Corrections of the department. Such order shall provide the name
- 22 of the person placed on probation, the crime, term of sentence,
- 23 date of sentence, period of probation, sex, race and a brief
- 24 history of the crime committed.
- 25 As compensation for such services they shall receive the sum
- 26 of Fifty Cents (50¢) for each transcript, and the sum shall be
- 27 paid out of the treasury of the county, with the approval of the
- 28 board of supervisors, on the filing of a bill for such service.
- SECTION 2. Section 99-19-47, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 30 amended as follows:
- 31 99-19-47. The following form, to be furnished by the county,
- 32 shall be used in transmitting the required data:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 99-19-45, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE CERTAIN DOCUMENTS AND INFORMATION BE INCLUDED IN COMMITMENT PAPERS SENT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS; TO AMEND SECTION 99-19-47, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM COMMITMENT FORM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
