## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1064

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 7 Section 75-63-59, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- If the contract is funded by trust, the 9 75-63-59. (1)
- 10 Secretary of State shall be given a copy of the trust document and
- shall be informed in writing as to how the assets of the trust are 11
- 12 In the event of any change in the investments of the assets
- 13 of the trust, or change in the trustee or trust institution, the
- Secretary of State shall be informed not less than thirty (30) 14
- days after the time such change occurs. 15
- 16 (2) Any trustee, other than a financial institution, shall
- not be the contract provider, the seller, or an officer or 17
- 18 director of the contract provider if the contract provider is a
- 19 corporation.
- 20 Within twenty (20) days from the end of the month in
- 21 which the funds were received, the contract seller shall place in
- a trust account in a financial institution as defined by this 22
- article at least eighty-five percent (85%) of the funds received. 23
- 24 If the contract seller places less than one hundred percent (100%)
- in the trust account, the preneed contract shall fully disclose to 25
- 26 the contract purchaser the amount deposited in trust and the
- 27 amount withheld by the contract seller.
- (4) Reasonable annual trust fees including any income taxes 28
- 29 owed to the State of Mississippi and/or the United States Treasury
- 30 may be withheld from the earnings of the trust.
- (5) At the time of death, if the contract provider provides 31
- 32 the merchandise and services indicated in the contract, the

- contract provider shall furnish to the trustee a copy of the 33
- 34 buyer's death certificate or proof of death and a letter of
- performance indicating that the contracted merchandise and 35
- services were provided by the contract provider to the contract 36
- insured. Upon receipt of the letter of performance and death 37
- certificate, or proof of death, the trustee shall pay to the 38
- contract provider all funds, which shall not be less than the 39
- 40 amount deposited in trust.
- (6) If the contract provider does not furnish merchandise 41
- and services as provided in the preneed contract, the trustee 42
- 43 shall pay to the estate of the contract insured or the substitute
- provider not less than the amount deposited in trust, within ten 44
- (10) days from notification of the death of the contract insured. 45
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 46
- 47 and after July 1, 2006.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 75-63-59, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1

- TO REQUIRE THAT CONTRACT SELLERS OF PRENEED FUNERAL SERVICES AND MERCHANDISE PLACE AT LEAST 85% OF THE FUNDS RECEIVED FOR SUCH

- 4 CONTRACTS FUNDED BY TRUST INTO A TRUST ACCOUNT IN A FINANCIAL
- 5 INSTITUTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
