Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1235

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. Section 11-1-52, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows:

7 11-1-52. (1) Any medical provider or hospital or nursing home or other medical facility shall charge no more than the 8 9 following amounts to patients or their representatives for 10 photocopying any patient's records: Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for 11 pages one (1) through twenty (20); One Dollar (\$1.00) per page for the next eighty (80) pages; Fifty Cents (50¢) per page for all 12 pages thereafter. Ten percent (10%) of the total charge may be 13 14 added for postage and handling. Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) may be recovered by the medical provider or hospital or nursing home or 15 16 other medical facility for retrieving medical records in archives 17 at a location off the premises where the facility/office is 18 located.

19 (2) A physician shall only charge normal, reasonable and 20 customary charges for a deposition related to a patient that the 21 physician is treating or has treated.

22 (3) Any medical provider, hospital, nursing home or other 23 medical facility shall charge no more than Twenty-five Dollars 24 (\$25.00) for executing a medical record affidavit, when the 25 affidavit is requested by the patient or the patient's

26 <u>representative</u>.

27 <u>(4) The medical provider, hospital, nursing home or other</u> 28 <u>medical facility shall comply with the federal Health Insurance</u> 29 <u>Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) provisions regarding</u> 30 <u>confidentiality of all records.</u>
