Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1312

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** Each full-time fire fighter, employed in
- 6 accordance with Section 45-11-203, policeman, sheriff, deputy
- 7 sheriff or other local law enforcement officer, who retires under
- 8 Section 21-29-139 or the Public Employees' Retirement System, for
- 9 superannuation or for reason of disability, or any other local
- 10 government retirement system shall be allowed to retain, as his
- 11 personal property, the one (1) badge which is issued to him by the
- 12 local government fire fighting unit or law enforcement unit.
- 13 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 14 and after July 1, 2006.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- L AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A FULL-TIME FIRE FIGHTER OR LAW
- 2 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER MAY RETAIN HIS BADGE WHEN HE RETIRES; AND FOR
- 3 RELATED PURPOSES.
