## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1556

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
7	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Office of Capital
8	Defense Counsel of the State of Mississippi for the purpose of
9	defraying the expenses of the office for the fiscal year beginning
10	July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007 \$ 844,420.00.
11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
12	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
13	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
14	expenditure:

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 35 36 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. 37 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 38 39 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 40 41 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Office of Capital Defense Counsel shall maintain complete 42 43 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 44 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 45 46 It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be 47 48 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 49 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 50 51 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Director of the Office of Capital Defense Counsel shall have the 52 53 authority to accept, budget and expend any source funds, not to 54 exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00). Such funds are 55 to be escalated in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner 56 57 consistent with escalation of federal funds. 58 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 59 60 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 61 62 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 63 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 64 65 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 66 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 67 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 68 69 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 70 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 71 72 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006. 73
