

**Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1558**

**TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:**

**THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:**

**AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

5       **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be  
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special  
7 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Office  
8 of Indigent Appeals which is comprised of special source funds  
9 collected by or otherwise available for the purpose of defraying  
10 the expenses of the Mississippi Office of Indigent Appeals for the  
11 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007.....  
12 ..... \$       1,166,832.00.

13       **SECTION 2.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of  
14 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be  
15 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of  
16 expenditure:

37 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with  
38 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or  
39 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State  
40 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written  
41 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The  
42 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written  
43 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions  
44 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the  
45 appropriated level.

46 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be  
47 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are  
48 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this  
49 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

50 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the  
51 Office of Indigent Appeals shall maintain complete accounting and  
52 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds  
53 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the  
54 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year  
55 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the  
56 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to  
57 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of  
58 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided  
59 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

60 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that  
61 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the  
62 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things  
63 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,  
64 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind  
65 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

66 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are  
67 made without competitive bids.

68         **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by  
69 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the  
70 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon  
71 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal  
72 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the  
73 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

74         **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
75 and after July 1, 2006.
