## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1561

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and
8	maintenance of the Mississippi Library Commission and for carrying
9	out the provisions of Section 39-3-107, Mississippi Code of 1972,
10	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending
11	June 30, 2007\$ 11,255,596.00.
12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
14	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
15	Library Commission which is comprised of special source funds
16	collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the
17	purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the fiscal
18	year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007

20	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
21	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
22	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater, beginning on July 1, 2006.

Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 56 57 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 58 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 59 60 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 61 62 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 63 64 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 65 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this

It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 67 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 68 69 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 70 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 71 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 72 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 73 74 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 75 76 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 77 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 78 79 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 80 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 81 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 82 The 83 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 84 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 85 86 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

91 Funds to be distributed to eligible public library systems 92 under the Personnel Incentive Grants Program shall be paid 93 quarterly in advance on or before September 30, December 31, March 94 31 and June 30.

95 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 96 Mississippi Library Commission shall maintain complete accounting 97 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 98 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 99 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 100 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the

H. B. 1561 PAGE 3 101 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to 102 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 103 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 104 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, Four Hundred Ninety-three Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-seven Dollars (\$493,847.00) shall be derived from the Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Library Commission shall have the authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated herein, not less than
One Million Eighty-six Thousand Three Hundred Forty Dollars
(\$1,086,340.00) shall be expended for the Magnolia Database.

SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 144 145 Executive Director of the Mississippi Library Commission may increase major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to 146 exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of 147 each major object of expenditure, provided that other major 148 149 objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar 150 amount and provided the Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Finance and Administration also approves with 151 152 written authorization. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages 153 and Fringe Benefits." 154

155 SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated herein, Three Million 156 Two Hundred Eighty-six Thousand Nine Hundred Forty-four Dollars 157 (\$3,286,944.00) is provided for the cost of health insurance for 158 all full-time library staff members in each public library in 159 Mississippi.

It is the intention of the Legislature that 160 SECTION 11. 161 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 162 163 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 164 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 165 166 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 167 made without competitive bids.

168 **SECTION 12.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 169 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 170 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 171 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 172 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 173 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 174 SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from 175 and after July 1, 2006.
