Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1563

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

20	medical assistance under the Mississippi Medicaid Law for the			
21	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007

23	SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be			
24	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special			
25	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Governor's Office			
26	- Division of Medicaid which is comprised of special source funds			
27	collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for the			
28	purpose of providing medical assistance under the Mississippi			
29	Medicaid Law and defraying the expenses of the administration of			
30	such law, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending

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Prior period recovery of funds may be maintained and expended by the division when the recovery is received or finalized.

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater, beginning on July 1, 2006.

Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

88 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 89 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 90 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 91 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 92 93 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 94 95 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 96 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 97 98 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 99 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 100 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 101

B. 1563 PAGE 3 102 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 103 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 104 105 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 106 107 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 108 109 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

110 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 111 112 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 113 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 114 The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 115 116 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 117 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level. 118

119 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 120 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 121 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 122 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

123 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 124 Governor's Office - Division of Medicaid shall maintain complete 125 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 126 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 127 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 128 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be 129 130 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 131 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 132

133 **SECTION 7.** In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 134 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 135 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 136 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 137 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 138 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted

A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee for Fiscal Year 2008.

150 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive Director of the Division of Medicaid may authorize 151 152 increases in any major objects of expenditures in total amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount 153 154 of each major object of expenditure, provided that other major 155 objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar 156 It is further the intention of the Legislature that any amount. 157 transfers made under the provision of this paragraph shall be of 158 an emergency nature and that in no case shall the transfers be 159 made which substantially alter the legislative intent for the 160 various programs as set forth in the original appropriations made 161 under this act. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and 162 163 Fringe Benefits."

SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that 164 165 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 166 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 167 168 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 169 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 170 made without competitive bids. 171

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SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 172 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 173 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 174 175 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 176 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 177 SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from 178 and after July 1, 2006. 179
