Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1564

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the State Department of Health for the
9	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
10	\$ 32,462,145.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department
14	of Health which is comprised of special source funds collected by
15	or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of
16	defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year
17	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
18	\$ 236,376,426.00.
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Section 2, Nine Million Eight Hundred Fifty-nine Thousand Five
21	Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$9,859,513.00) shall be derived from the
22	Health Care Expendable Fund, created in Section 43-13-407,
23	Mississippi Code of 1972, for the support and maintenance of the
24	State Department of Health. The funds provided in this section
25	shall be allocated as follows:

34	Trauma Care System funds to the Division of Medicaid for the
35	development and implementation of an enhanced reimbursement fee
36	program related to trauma care and services, used to match federal
37	funds, under a cooperative agreement between the State Department
38	of Health and the Division of Medicaid.
39	It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the Four
40	Million One Hundred Eighty Thousand Seven Hundred Twelve Dollars
41	(\$4,180,712.00) authorized herein for the Trauma Care System shall
42	be expended to the benefit of any hospital located outside the
43	boundaries of the State of Mississippi, unless otherwise excepted
44	in this paragraph. Further, unless otherwise excepted in this
45	paragraph, no such out-of-state hospital shall be authorized to
46	receive such funds until such time as the amount appropriated for
47	such purpose shall reach an amount of Eight Million Dollars
48	(\$8,000,000.00) or more. Funds shall be expended by the
49	Mississippi Department of Health for distribution to the Regional
50	Medical Center at Memphis, located in Memphis, Tennessee, for
51	their participation in the Trauma Care System.
52	SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
53	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
54	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

81	Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel
82	Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds
83	available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006
84	agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result
85	in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another
86	employee within the same agency, with the same job classification
87	series and greater longevity.
88	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
89	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
90	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
91	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
92	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
93	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
94	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
95	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
96	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
97	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
98	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
99	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
100	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal

101 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.

102 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal

Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 103

104 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this

projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 105

106 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which

107 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation

108 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until

109 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 110

111 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or

allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 112

Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 113

approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 114 The

115 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written

116 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 117

118 appropriated level.

119 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

120 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

121 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this

122 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

123 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the

124 State Department of Health shall maintain complete accounting and

personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds

appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 126

same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 127

128 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the

129 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to

130 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of

detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 131

132 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets

set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the

agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget

Committee for Fiscal Year 2008.

Mississippi Department of Health shall have authority to escalate the various budgets in both funds and positions, with the approval of the State Fiscal Officer, from any special funds collected or available, in the current fiscal year or any prior fiscal year, not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00), to the agency for expenditure. Upon such approval, the Mississippi Department of Health may expend such funds in the manner authorized by law.

The Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Health shall submit to the Department of Finance and Administration a certified statement providing a detailed explanation for any escalation, including a justification for the establishment of any new positions or reclassification of existing positions and the existence of any required matching funds for those positions, and an assessment of the impact on the agency's General Fund Budget for the three (3) fiscal years following the fiscal year in which the escalation is requested.

SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that with the funds provided herein, the State Department of Health may provide and administer without charge, Hepatitis B vaccinations to Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel who are in need of such vaccinations through job related exposure.

220	"Lorenzo's Oil" for the treatment of the genetic disorder	
221	adrenoleukodystrophy (ALD), to children and Mississippi residents	
222	over the age of twenty-one (21) who have the genetic disorder	
223	adrenoleukodystrophy and for whom Medicaid does not reimburse the	
224	cost of providing the oil. The department may also provide needed	
225	pathology and biannual MRI exams.	
226	SECTION 12. In addition to all other funds heretofore	
227	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be	
228	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money deposited in	
229	the State Treasury from the Mississippi Tobacco Pilot Program as	
230	authorized in the case <u>Mike Moore Attorney General ex rel. State</u>	
231	of Mississippi v. The American Tobacco Company et al. (Chancery	
232	Court of Jackson County, Mississippi, Cause No. 94-1429) to the	
233	State Department of Health for the fiscal year beginning	
234	July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007 \$ 5,000,000.00.	
235	It is the intention of the Legislature that of the funds	
236	appropriated in this section, an amount not less than Two Million	
237	Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) is provided to fund	
238	the School Tobacco Nurse Program.	

- SECTION 13. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Seven
 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) are provided for the
 purpose of purchasing AIDS drugs and other necessary AIDS related
 medical services.
- section 14. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 3,
 the amounts of One Hundred Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-seven
 Dollars (\$110,977.00) shall be allocated to the T.K. Martin Center
 at Mississippi State University and One Hundred Ten Thousand Nine
 Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars (\$110,977.00) shall be allocated to
 the Regional Rehabilitation Center in Tupelo for the Early
 Intervention Program.
- 250 **SECTION 15.** Of the funds appropriated herein, Fifty Thousand 251 Dollars (\$50,000.00) is provided for the Breast and Cervical 252 Cancer Program.
- 253 SECTION 16. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 254 Executive Director of the State Department of Health may authorize increases in major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to 255 256 exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of 257 each major object of expenditure, provided that other major 258 objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar 259 amount. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase 260 the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe 261 Benefits."
- 262 SECTION 17. In addition to all other funds heretofore 263 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 264 265 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Burn Care Fund which is comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise 266 267 available to the department, for the purpose of funding the 268 development of a plan for delivery of services and of providing reimbursement for uncompensated medical care to Mississippi burn 269 270 victims through the trauma care system, for the fiscal year 271 beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... 272\$3,000,000.00.

SECTION 18. It is the intention of the Legislature that 273 274 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 275 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 276 277 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 278 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 279 made without competitive bids. 280

SECTION 19. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 20. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006.
