## **Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1567**

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Soil and
8	Water Conservation Commission for the purpose of defraying the
9	administrative expenses of the commission and carrying out the
10	provisions of Section 69-27-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972,
11	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending
12	June 30, 2007\$ 736,627.00.
13	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
14	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
15	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Soil and
16	Water Conservation Commission which is comprised of special source
17	funds collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for
18	the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the
19	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
20	\$ 3,302,150.00.
21	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
22	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
23	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
24	expenditure:

45	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
46	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
47	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
48	Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater,
49	beginning on July 1, 2006.
50	Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel
51	Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds
52	available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006
53	agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result
54	in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another
55	employee within the same agency, with the same job classification
56	series and greater longevity.
57	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
58	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
59	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
60	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
61	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
62	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
63	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
64	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
65	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
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66 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this

67 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure

- that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 68
- 69 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
- 70 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 71 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 72 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 73 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 74 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
- appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 75
- 76 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 77 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 78
- 79 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 80 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 81 allowable under the terms set forth within this act.
- Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 82
- 83 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
- 84 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 85 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 86 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 87 appropriated level.
- 88 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 89 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 90 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 91
- SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 92
- State Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall maintain 93
- 94 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 95 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 96
- 97 maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of
- 98 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 99
- 100 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level

- 101 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request 102 process.
- SECTION 5. The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission 103
- 104 is hereby authorized to retain all funds generated from the sale
- of equipment. Any funds made available from the sale of equipment 105
- 106 shall be deposited into the special fund in the State Treasury to
- 107 the credit of the Soil and Water Conservation Commission and shall
- 108 be used solely for the purpose of purchasing equipment.
- 109 SECTION 6. The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission
- 110 is hereby authorized to receive, budget and expend any proceeds
- 111 derived from the sale of bonds authorized in Section 69-27-331 et
- seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. All expenditures shall be in 112
- accordance with conditions provided in Section 69-27-331 et seq., 113
- 114 Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 115 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 116 Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall have the authority to
- escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed 117
- 118 Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) in accordance
- 119 with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
- Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 120
- 121 federal funds.
- 122 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the
- 123 intention of the Legislature that an amount not to exceed
- 124 Sixty-five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000.00) be used for the purpose
- 125 of funding a Beaver Control Cost Share program. The Mississippi
- 126 Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall promulgate rules and
- regulations for the establishment and operation of the program on 127
- 128 a fund matching basis with the county unit of government.
- 129 not expended or encumbered in a county may be transferred to
- 130 another county during the fiscal year. Only those funds
- specifically appropriated for the Beaver Control Cost Share 131
- 132 program shall be used in any such program.
- It is the intention of the Legislature that 133 SECTION 9.
- whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 134
- purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 135

136 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

137 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

138 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

139 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

140 made without competitive bids.

141 **SECTION 10.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by

142 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

143 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

147 **SECTION 11.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

148 and after July 1, 2006.
