Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1569

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Arts

16	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for
17	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007.

19	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
20	of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

26	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation

п. в. 1569 PAGE 1 Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 38 39 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 40 41 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 42 43 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 44 45 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 46 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 47 48 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 49 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 50 51 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 52 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 53 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 54 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 55 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 56 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 57 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 58 59 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written

H. B. 1569 PAGE 2 66 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 67 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 68 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

73 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 74 Mississippi Arts Commission shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 75 76 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 77 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 78 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 79 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to 80 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 81 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 82

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
Section 2, funds in the amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand
Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall be derived from the Education
Enhancement Fund pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31,
Mississippi Code of 1972, for the following:

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Training of educators and promotion

89 of arts programs in public schools . . . \$100,000.00 90 Miscellaneous grants and programs \$350,000.00 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 91 92 Arts Commission shall have the authority to transfer dollars appropriated herein designated for the "Challenge Program," 93 94 specific amounts to a special fund in the State Treasury called 95 the Arts Commission Challenge Initiative Fund. The unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall 96 97 not lapse into the State General Fund and may be expended by the 98 commission in subsequent fiscal years upon appropriation of the Legislature. Any interest earned on the fund shall be deposited 99 100 to the credit of the fund and may be disbursed by the commission

It is the intention of 102 the Legislature that the commission may award grants to arts 103 organizations from monies in the fund and the grantees will be 104 required to provide matching funds for the grants in an amount of 105 not less than two (2) times the amount of the grant.

SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi Arts Commission shall have the authority to escalate its budget and expend funds from any source available not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00), that may become available to the commission in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that 113 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 114 115 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 116 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 117 118 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 119 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 120 made without competitive bids.

121 SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 122 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 123 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 124 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 125 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 126 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from 127 and after July 1, 2006. 128
