THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

12	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

14	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Grand Gulf		
15	Military Monument Commission, for the purpose of defraying the		
16	expenses of the commission in the operation and maintenance of the		
17	Grand Gulf Military Monument for the fiscal year beginning		
18	July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007\$ 88,411.0	0.	
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions	of	
20	Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall		
21	be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

43	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation				
44	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase				
45	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation				
46	Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater,				
47	beginning on July 1, 2006.				
48	Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel				
49	Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds				
50	available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006				
51	agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result				
52	in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another				
53	employee within the same agency, with the same job classification				
54	series and greater longevity.				
55	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of				
56	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to				
57	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal				
58	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007				
59	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions				
60	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the				
61	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the				
62	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall				
63	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all				
64	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this				
65	act. It shall be t	he responsibility of the agency	head to insure		
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66 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual

67 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal

- 68 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
- 69 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 70 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- 71 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
- 72 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
- 73 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 74 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 75 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 76 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 77 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 78 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 79 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 80 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 81 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 82 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 83 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 84 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 85 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 87 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 88 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 89 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 90 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 91 Grand Gulf Military Monument Commission shall maintain complete
- 92 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 93 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- 94 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 95 Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 96 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be
- 97 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 98 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 99 provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

SECTION 5. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or 100 101 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of 102 103 Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of 104 105 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof. 106 It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles 107 authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply 108 with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972. SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that 109 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 110 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 111 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 112 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 113 114 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 115 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids. 116 117 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 118 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 119 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 120 121 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 122 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from

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and after July 1, 2006.
