## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1577

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of
7	Rehabilitation Services for the fiscal year beginning
8	July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007 \$ 9,154,665.00.
9	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
10	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
11	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Department of
12	Rehabilitation Services which is comprised of special source funds
13	collected by or otherwise available to the department for the
14	support of the various offices of the department, for the purpose
15	of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year
16	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007

18	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
19	Section 2, Five Million Seventy-one Thousand One Hundred Eighteen
20	Dollars (\$5,071,118.00) shall be derived from the Health Care
21	Expendable Fund created in Section 43-13-407, Mississippi Code of
22	1972. The above funds shall be allocated as follows:

B. 1577 PAGE 5 Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 176 177 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 178 179 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 180 181 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 182 183 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 184 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 185 186 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 187 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 188 189 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 190 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 191 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 192 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 193 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 194 195 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 196 197 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written

H. B. 1577 PAGE 6 204 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 205 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 206 appropriated level.

207 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 208 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 209 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 210 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

211 It is the intention of the Legislature that the Executive 212 Director of the Department of Rehabilitation Services may transfer between the various offices authorized herein both funds and 213 214 positions not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the receiving office in addition to any other transfers or escalations made in 215 accordance with Section 27-104-17(3), Mississippi Code of 1972, 216 217 Annotated. The Executive Director of the Department of 218 Rehabilitation Services shall submit written justification for the 219 transfer to the Legislative Budget Office and the Department of Finance and Administration on or before the fifteenth of the month 220 221 prior to the effective date of the transfer. It is further the 222 intention of the Legislature that any transfers made under the 223 provisions of this paragraph shall be of an emergency nature and 224 that in no case shall the transfers be made which substantially 225 alter the legislative intent for the various offices as set forth 226 in the original appropriations made under this act.

227 SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein 228 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 229 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds which are 230 received by or otherwise become available to the Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services to provide funding for 231 232 construction grants and establishment grants for the fiscal year 233 beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... 234 4,000,000.00.

235 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 236 Department of Rehabilitation Services shall maintain complete 237 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 238 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 239 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 240 Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 241 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be 242 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 243 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 244 provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

SECTION 7. It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.

It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles authorized to be owned and operated by this agency shall comply with Sections 25-1-77 through 25-1-93, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 8. Of the funds in Sections 1, 2 and 3, the Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services through the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation for the Blind is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for the National Federation for the Blind (NFB) News line service to allow blind and visually impaired persons to access newspapers through toll-free telephone calls.

261 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that 262 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 263 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 264 265 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 266 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 267 268 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. **SECTION 11.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006.
