Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1581

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Physical
9	Therapy, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
10	Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy for the fiscal year
11	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
12	\$ 233,642.00.
13	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
14	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
15	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
16	Permanent: Full Time 2
17	Part Time 1
18	Time-Limited: Full Time
19	Part Time0
20	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
21	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
22	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
23	Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater,
24	beginning on July 1, 2006.
25	Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel
26	Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds
27	available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006
28	agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result
29	in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another
30	employee within the same agency, with the same job classification
31	series and greater longevity.

32 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 33 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 34 35 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 36 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 38 39 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 40 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 41 42 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 43 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 45 46 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 47 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 48 49 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 50 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 51 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 52 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 53 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 54 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 55 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 56 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 57 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 58 59 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 60 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 61 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 62 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 67 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy shall maintain 68 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 69 70 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 71 maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of 72 73 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 74 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 75 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request 76

78 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 79 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 80 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 81 82 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 83 84 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 85 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
