AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 89 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 90 maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of

- 96 SECTION 4. In accordance with the purposes of this article,

- 101 President Street, Jackson, Mississippi. At the end of each fiscal

102 year, any and all unexpended funds shall be transferred to the

It is the intention of the Legislature that the system have the authority to escalate the Public Employees' Retirement System Building Repair and Maintenance Fund in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for repair and maintenance of the buildings owned by the system. expenditures from the Public Employees' Retirement System Building Repair and Maintenance Fund shall be in accordance with this article and for the purposes designated herein.

whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006.
