Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1588

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Veterans Memorial
8	Stadium Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
9	Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission for the fiscal
10	year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
11	\$ 1,430,736.00.
12	In addition to the funds appropriated herein, the Mississippi
13	Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission is hereby authorized to
14	disburse to participating institutions, agencies or departments
15	their shares or divisions of gate receipts.
16	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
17	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
18	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
19	expenditure:

40	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
41	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
42	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
43	Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater,
44	beginning on July 1, 2006.
45	Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel
46	Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds
47	available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006
48	agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result
49	in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another
50	employee within the same agency, with the same job classification
51	series and greater longevity.
52	With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
53	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
54	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
55	Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
56	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
57	are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
58	Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
59	Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
60	determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
61	appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
62	act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
63	that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
64	cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
65	Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.

- 66 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
- 67 Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
- has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 68
- 69 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
- 70 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 71 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 72 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 73 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- 74 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 75
- 76 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 77 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 78 The
- 79 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 80 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 81 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- appropriated level. 82
- 83 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 84 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 85
- 86 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 87 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 88 Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission shall maintain
- 89 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 90 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 91
- maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of 92
- the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 93
- 94 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 95 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request 96
- 97 process.
- SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 98
- 99 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 100 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

101 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

102 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

103 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

104 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are

105 made without competitive bids.

section 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

111 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

112 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

113 and after July 1, 2006.
