Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1592

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater, beginning on July 1, 2006.

Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

46 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 47 48 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 49 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 50 51 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 52 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 53 54 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 55 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 56 act. 57 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 58 59 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 60 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 61 62 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 63 64 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 65 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation

H. B. 1592 PAGE 2 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board untilsuch time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 68 69 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 70 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 71 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 72 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 73 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 74 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 75 76 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

81 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Tombigbee River Valley Water Management District shall maintain 82 83 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 84 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 85 maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of 86 87 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 88 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 89 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 90 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request 91 process.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 92 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 93 94 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 95 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 96 97 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 98 99 made without competitive bids.

All monies in possession of the district in excess of necessary operating funds shall be deposited with a bank or banks selected by the board of directors of the district. These funds shall be deposited in such bank or banks and in such manner that interest earned shall be at least equal to interest earnings on state funds deposited by the State Treasury.

106 **SECTION 6.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall 107 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 108 or officers, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2006.
