Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1594

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

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32 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 33 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

38 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 39 Yellow Creek State Inland Port Authority shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 40 41 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 42 Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 43 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be 44 45 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 46 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 47

48 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 49 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 50 51 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 52 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 53 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 54 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 55 made without competitive bids.

56 **SECTION 5.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall 57 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 58 or officers, in the manner provided by law.

59 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 60 and after July 1, 2006.
