

Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1595

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out
7 of any funds which are received by or otherwise become available
8 to the Mississippi Coast Coliseum Commission, for the purpose of
9 defraying expenses of the commission for the fiscal year beginning
10 July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007.....
11 \$ 3,980,272.00.

12 **SECTION 2.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
15 expenditure:

16 **MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE:**

17 Personal Services:

19 Travel and Subsistence..... 42,500.00
20 Contractual Services..... 1,680,000.00

27 **AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:**

28 Permanent: Full Time..... 46

32 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
33 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

34 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
35 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
36 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
37 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

38 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
39 Mississippi Coast Coliseum Commission shall maintain complete
40 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
41 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
42 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
43 Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
44 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be
45 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
46 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
47 provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

48 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
49 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
50 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
51 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
52 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
53 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
54 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
55 made without competitive bids.

56 **SECTION 5.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall
57 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer
58 or officers, in the manner provided by law.

59 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
60 and after July 1, 2006.
