Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1602

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation

Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase

equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation

Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater,

beginning on July 1, 2006.

Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"

- 84 or federal law, or rules or regulations that implement state or

- SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 86
- 87 Public Service Commission shall maintain complete accounting and
- 88 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 89 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 90 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 91
- agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to 92
- the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 93
- 94 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 95 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.
- SECTION 5. In addition to all other sums herein 96
- 97 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 98 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury
- to the credit of the Public Service Commission, for the purpose of 99
- 100 defraying the expenses of the Public Service Commission to

104	SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that
105	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
106	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
107	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
108	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
109	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
110	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
111	made without competitive bids.
112	SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
113	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
114	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
115	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
116	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
117	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law
118	SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from
119	and after July 1, 2006.
