COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting
in lieu thereof the following:**

34 SECTION 1. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle, who is a
35 resident of this state, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws
36 relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon
37 payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes
38 and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of
39 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles,
40 and upon payment of an additional annual fee in the amount
41 provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a
42 special license tag for each motor vehicle registered in his name
43 identifying such person as a supporter of Support Our Troops, Inc.
44 The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and
45 design as the State Tax Commission, with the advice of the Support
46 Our Troops, Inc., may prescribe, and shall consist of such letters
47 or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each
48 license tag.

49 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
50 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
51 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the
52 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less

53 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,
54 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis
55 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional
56 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the
57 county general fund.

58 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
59 after July 1, 2006, any person applying for a distinctive license
60 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount
61 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag
62 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all
63 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a
64 period of time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established
65 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the
66 time the original application is made for a distinctive license
67 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of
68 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive
69 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive
70 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax
71 collector.

72 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
73 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
74 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the
75 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the
76 distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State
77 Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:

78 (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee
79 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
80 section shall be disbursed to the Support Our Troops, Inc.

81 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
82 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
83 be deposited into the Mississippi Burn Care Center Fund created
84 pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

85 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
86 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
87 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
88 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
89 reconstruction of highways.

90 (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
91 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
92 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section
93 27-19-44.2.

94 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
95 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
96 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
97 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
98 this section. The tax collector shall issue month and year decals
99 for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, which
100 will expire the same month and year as the regular license tag.

101 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
102 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
103 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
104 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license
105 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving
106 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and
107 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee
108 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be
109 distributed proportionately in the same manner as funds from the
110 sale of regular distinctive license tags issued under this
111 section.

112 **SECTION 2.** (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a
113 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge
114 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as
115 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup
116 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of

117 an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (3) of this
118 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor
119 vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a
120 supporter of organ recovery. The distinctive license tags so
121 issued shall be of such color and design as the State Tax
122 Commission, with the advice of the Mississippi Organ Recovery
123 Agency, may prescribe and shall consist of such letters or
124 numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license
125 tag.

126 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
127 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
128 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the
129 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less
130 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,
131 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis
132 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional
133 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the
134 county general fund.

135 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
136 after July 1, 2006, any person applying for a distinctive license
137 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount
138 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag
139 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all
140 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a
141 period of time to run concurrently with the vehicle's established
142 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the
143 time the original application is made for a distinctive license
144 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of
145 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive

161 be deposited into the Mississippi Fire Fighter's Memorial Burn
162 Center Fund created pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

163 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
164 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
165 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
166 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
167 reconstruction of highways.

168 (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
169 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
170 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section
171 27-19-44.2.

172 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
173 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
174 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
175 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
176 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
177 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
178 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
179 tag.

180 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
181 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
182 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
183 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license
184 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving
185 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and
186 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee
187 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be
188 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular
189 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

190 **SECTION 3.** (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle, who is a
191 resident of this state, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws
192 relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, and upon
193 payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes
194 and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of
195 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles,
196 and upon payment of an additional annual fee in the amount
197 provided in subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a
198 special license tag for each motor vehicle registered in his name
199 identifying such person as a supporter of the Junior League of
200 Jackson. The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such
201 color and design as the State Tax Commission, with the advice of
202 the Junior League of Jackson, may prescribe, and shall consist of
203 such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to
204 distinguish each license tag.

205 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
206 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
207 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the
208 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less
209 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,
210 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis
211 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional

212 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the
213 county general fund.

214 (3) Beginning with any registration year commencing on or
215 after July 1, 2006, any person applying for a distinctive license
216 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount
217 of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each distinctive license tag applied
218 for under this section, which shall be in addition to all other
219 taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of
220 time to run concurrent with the vehicle's established license tag
221 year. The additional fee is due and payable at the time the
222 original application is made for a distinctive license tag under
223 this section and thereafter annually at the time of renewal
224 registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license
225 tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license
226 tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax collector.

227 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees into the
228 State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each month,
229 the State Tax Commission shall certify to the State Treasurer the
230 total fees collected under this section from the issuance of the
231 distinctive license tags issued under this section. The State
232 Treasurer shall distribute such collections as follows:

233 (a) Forty-four Dollars (\$44.00) of each additional fee
234 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
235 section shall be disbursed to the Mississippi Children's Museum, a
236 Mississippi nonprofit corporation.

237 (b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
238 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
239 be deposited into the Mississippi Burn Care Center Fund created
240 pursuant to Section 7-9-70.

241 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
242 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
243 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund

244 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
245 reconstruction of highways.

246 (d) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
247 on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
248 be deposited to the credit of the special fund created in Section
249 27-19-44.2.

285 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the
286 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less
287 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,
288 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis
289 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional
290 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the

504 **SECTION 7.** In recognition of the patriotic service rendered
505 by Mississippians who are veterans of the United States Armed
506 Forces, any such person is privileged to obtain distinctive
507 motorcycle license plates or tags for each motorcycle registered
508 in his name identifying his status as a veteran. The State Tax
509 Commission, with concurrence by the State Veterans Affairs Board,
510 shall develop decals to be affixed to the license tag indicating
511 branch and period of military service. The distinctive plates or
512 tags shall be of a color and design designated by the Tax
513 Commission with concurrence by the State Veterans Affairs Board.

514 The distinctive license plates shall be prepared by the Tax
515 Commission and shall be issued through the tax collectors of the
516 counties in the same manner as are other motor vehicle license
517 plates or tags. An additional annual tag fee of Thirty Dollars
518 (\$30.00) shall be collected by the tax collector for such license
519 plates or tags and shall be remitted to the Tax Commission on a
520 monthly basis as prescribed by the commission. The additional fee
521 is due and payable at the time the original application is made
522 for a distinctive tag under this section and thereafter annually
523 at the time of renewal registration as long as the owner retains
524 the distinctive license tag. The State Tax Commission shall
525 deposit such fee to the credit of a fund to be administered by the
526 board overseeing the veterans nursing homes in this state for the
527 benefit of indigent veterans who are residents of such nursing
528 homes.
