Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 SECTION 1. Section 99-19-45, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 8 99-19-45. The clerks of the circuit court of the counties in 9 10 the State of Mississippi shall furnish the Mississippi Department of Corrections, within five (5) days after adjournment of court, a 11 commitment paper showing the name, sex, race and social security 12 number of the person convicted * * * and * * * the crime 13 14 committed, along with certified copies of the sentencing order and indictment, as well as any subsequent order entered by the court 15 16 in such cause. 17 The clerks shall also furnish the Department of Corrections, within five (5) days after adjournment of such court, a certified 18 copy of the probation order of an individual who is placed on 19 20 probation under the supervision of the Division of Community Corrections of the department. Such order shall provide the name 21 22 of the person placed on probation, the crime, term of sentence, 23 date of sentence, period of probation, sex, race and a brief 24 history of the crime committed.

25	As compensation for such services they shall receive the sum									
26	of Fifty Cents (50¢) for each transcript, and the sum shall be									
27	paid out of the treasury of the county, with the approval of the									
28	board of supervisors, on the filing of a bill for such service.
