11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi
14	Authority for Educational Television which is comprised of special
15	source funds collected by or otherwise available to the Authority,
16	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Authority for the
17	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007

19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below
21	shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of

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With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
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    the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
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    make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
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    Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
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    funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
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    are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
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    Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
    Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
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    determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
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    appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
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          It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
    that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
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    cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
    Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
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    If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
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    Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
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    has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
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    projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
    appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
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    reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
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    requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
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    such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
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         Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
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    the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
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    allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
    Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
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    approval from the Department of Finance and Administration.
    Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
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    approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
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    without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
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appropriated level.

- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 86 87 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

- 90 Funds appropriated herein shall first be used for the

- SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 95
- 96 Mississippi Authority for Educational Television shall maintain
- complete accounting and personnel records related to the 97

- records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 99
- maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of 100
- 101 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 102 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 103 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 104 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request

- SECTION 6. No part of the funds appropriated herein shall be 111

155	Committee for Fiscal Year 2008.
156	SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
157	Executive Director of the Mississippi Authority for Educational
158	Television may increase major objects of expenditure in total
159	amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the
160	appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided
161	that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a
162	corresponding dollar amount and provided the Executive Director of
163	the Mississippi Department of Finance and Administration also
164	approves with written authorization. However, no transfers shall
165	be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure
166	"Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."
167	SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that
168	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
169	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
170	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
171	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
172	shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
173	the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
174	made without competitive bids.
175	SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
176	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
177	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
178	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
179	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

181 **SECTION 13.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 182 and after July 1, 2006.
