## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses of the State Department of Health for the
9	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
10	\$ 32,462,145.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in any special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Department
14	of Health which is comprised of special source funds collected by
15	or otherwise available to the department, for the purpose of
16	defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal year
17	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
18	\$ 236,376,426.00.
19	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
20	Section 2, Nine Million Eight Hundred Fifty-nine Thousand Five
21	Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$9,859,513.00) shall be derived from the
22	Health Care Expendable Fund, created in Section 43-13-407,
23	Mississippi Code of 1972, for the support and maintenance of the

24 State Department of Health. The funds provided in this section 25 shall be allocated as follows:

33 The State Department of Health may transfer a portion of 34 Trauma Care System funds to the Division of Medicaid for the 35 development and implementation of an enhanced reimbursement fee 36 program related to trauma care and services, used to match federal 37 funds, under a cooperative agreement between the State Department 38 of Health and the Division of Medicaid.

It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the Four 39 40 Million One Hundred Eighty Thousand Seven Hundred Twelve Dollars 41 (\$4,180,712.00) authorized herein for the Trauma Care System shall be expended to the benefit of any hospital located outside the 42 43 boundaries of the State of Mississippi, unless otherwise excepted in this paragraph. Further, unless otherwise excepted in this 44 45 paragraph, no such out-of-state hospital shall be authorized to receive such funds until such time as the amount appropriated for 46 such purpose shall reach an amount of Eight Million Dollars 47 48 (\$8,000,000.00) or more. Funds shall be expended by the Mississippi Department of Health for distribution to the Regional 49 50 Medical Center at Memphis, located in Memphis, Tennessee, for their participation in the Trauma Care System. 51

52 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 53 Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall 54 be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 55 expenditure:

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater, beginning on July 1, 2006.

Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 88 89 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 90 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 91 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 92 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 93 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 94 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 95 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 96 97 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 98 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 99 100 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 101 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 102 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 103 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 104 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 105 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 106 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 107 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 108 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 109 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

110 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 111 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 112 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 113 114 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 115 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 116 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 117 118 appropriated level.

119 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 120 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 121 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 122 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

123 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 124 State Department of Health shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 125 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 126 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 127 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 128 129 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to 130 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 131 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 132 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

SECTION 6. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

175	SECTION 7. It is the intent of the Legislature that the	
176	Mississippi Department of Health shall have authority to escalate	
177	the various budgets in both funds and positions, with the approval	
178	of the State Fiscal Officer, from any special funds collected or	
179	available, in the current fiscal year or any prior fiscal year,	
180	not to exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00), to the agency	
181	for expenditure. Upon such approval, the Mississippi Department	
182	of Health may expend such funds in the manner authori	zed by law.

The Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of 183 184 Health shall submit to the Department of Finance and 185 Administration a certified statement providing a detailed 186 explanation for any escalation, including a justification for the 187 establishment of any new positions or reclassification of existing 188 positions and the existence of any required matching funds for 189 those positions, and an assessment of the impact on the agency's 190 General Fund Budget for the three (3) fiscal years following the 191 fiscal year in which the escalation is requested.

192 **SECTION 8.** It is the intention of the Legislature that with 193 the funds provided herein, the State Department of Health may 194 provide and administer without charge, Hepatitis B vaccinations to 195 Emergency Medical Services (EMS) personnel who are in need of such 196 vaccinations through job related exposure.

197 SECTION 9. In addition to all other sums heretofore 198 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 199 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 200 Treasury to the credit of the Local Governments and Rural Water 201 Systems Emergency Loan Fund, and the Local Governments and Rural 202 Water System Improvements Revolving Loan Fund as authorized in 203 Chapter 521, Laws of 1995, to the State Department of Health for 204 the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Local Governments and 205 Rural Water Systems Improvements Board, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... 206 207 28,000,000.00. .....\$ 208 SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One 209 Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) shall come from the Department of Human Services, Child Care Development Fund or other appropriate 210

211 special funds for the purpose of child care licensure. These 212 funds are to be transferred to the State Department of Health no 213 later than July 31, 2006. The State Department of Health shall

214 make a complete accounting of the uses of these funds to the 215 Department of Human Services.

SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 216 217 State Department of Health shall expend not more than Fifty 218 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and allocated in Section 4 for providing the oil known as 219 220 "Lorenzo's Oil" for the treatment of the genetic disorder 221 adrenoleukodystrophy (ALD), to children and Mississippi residents 222 over the age of twenty-one (21) who have the genetic disorder adrenoleukodystrophy and for whom Medicaid does not reimburse the 223 224 cost of providing the oil. The department may also provide needed pathology and biannual MRI exams. 225

SECTION 12. In addition to all other funds heretofore 226 227 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money deposited in 228 229 the State Treasury from the Mississippi Tobacco Pilot Program as 230 authorized in the case Mike Moore Attorney General ex rel. State of Mississippi v. The American Tobacco Company et al. (Chancery 231 Court of Jackson County, Mississippi, Cause No. 94-1429) to the 232 233 State Department of Health for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007.....\$ 5,000,000.00. 234 235 It is the intention of the Legislature that of the funds 236 appropriated in this section, an amount not less than Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) is provided to fund 237 238 the School Tobacco Nurse Program.

**SECTION 13.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) are provided for the purpose of purchasing AIDS drugs and other necessary AIDS related medical services.

243 **SECTION 14.** Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 3, 244 the amounts of One Hundred Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-seven 245 Dollars (\$110,977.00) shall be allocated to the T.K. Martin Center at Mississippi State University and One Hundred Ten Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-seven Dollars (\$110,977.00) shall be allocated to the Regional Rehabilitation Center in Tupelo for the Early Intervention Program.

250 **SECTION 15.** Of the funds appropriated herein, Fifty Thousand 251 Dollars (\$50,000.00) is provided for the Breast and Cervical 252 Cancer Program.

253 SECTION 16. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 254 Executive Director of the State Department of Health may authorize 255 increases in major objects of expenditure in total amounts not to 256 exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of 257 each major object of expenditure, provided that other major 258 objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar 259 amount. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase 260 the major object of expenditure "Salaries, Wages and Fringe 261 Benefits."

SECTION 17. In addition to all other funds heretofore 262 263 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 264 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 265 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Burn Care Fund which is 266 comprised of special source funds collected by or otherwise 267 available to the department, for the purpose of funding the 268 development of a plan for delivery of services and of providing 269 reimbursement for uncompensated medical care to Mississippi burn 270 victims through the trauma care system, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007..... 271 272 .....\$3,000,000.00.

273 **SECTION 18.** It is the intention of the Legislature that 274 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 275 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 276 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 277 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

278 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 279 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 280 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 19. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 281 282 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 283 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 284 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 285 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 286 SECTION 20. This act shall take effect and be in force from 287 288 and after July 1, 2006.
