## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
б	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the State Soil and
8	Water Conservation Commission for the purpose of defraying the
9	administrative expenses of the commission and carrying out the
10	provisions of Section 69-27-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972,
11	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending
12	June 30, 2007\$ 736,627.00.
13	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
14	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
15	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Soil and
16	Water Conservation Commission which is comprised of special source
17	funds collected by or otherwise available to the commission, for
18	the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for the
19	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
20	\$ 3,302,150.00.
21	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
22	Section 1 and Section 2, not more than the amounts set forth below

23 shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 24 expenditure:

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater, beginning on July 1, 2006.

50 Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel 51 Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds 52 available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 53 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result 54 in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another

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55 employee within the same agency, with the same job classification 56 series and greater longevity.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 57 58 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 59 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 60 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 61 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 62 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 63 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 64 65 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 66 67 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 68 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 69 70 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 71 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 72 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 73 74 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 75 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 76 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 77 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 78 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 79 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 80 81 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 82 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 83 The

84 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 85 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

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86 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 87 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 92 State Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall maintain 93 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 94 95 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 96 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of 97 98 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 99 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 100 101 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request 102 process.

**SECTION 5.** The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission is hereby authorized to retain all funds generated from the sale of equipment. Any funds made available from the sale of equipment shall be deposited into the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Soil and Water Conservation Commission and shall be used solely for the purpose of purchasing equipment.

**SECTION 6.** The State Soil and Water Conservation Commission is hereby authorized to receive, budget and expend any proceeds derived from the sale of bonds authorized in Section 69-27-331 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972. All expenditures shall be in accordance with conditions provided in Section 69-27-331 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

115 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 116 Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall have the authority to 117 escalate its budget and expend funds from any source not to exceed Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) in accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

122 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the 123 intention of the Legislature that an amount not to exceed Sixty-five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000.00) be used for the purpose 124 of funding a Beaver Control Cost Share program. The Mississippi 125 126 Soil and Water Conservation Commission shall promulgate rules and 127 regulations for the establishment and operation of the program on 128 a fund matching basis with the county unit of government. Funds not expended or encumbered in a county may be transferred to 129 130 another county during the fiscal year. Only those funds specifically appropriated for the Beaver Control Cost Share 131 132 program shall be used in any such program.

133 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that 134 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 135 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 136 137 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 138 139 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 140 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 141 142 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 143 144 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 145 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 146 147 SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from 148 and after July 1, 2006.
