## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

16	purpose of defraying the expenses of the department for the fiscal		
17	year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 55 56 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 57 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 58 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 59 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 60 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 61 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 62 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 63 64 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 65 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 66 67 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 68 69 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 70 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 71 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 72 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 73 74 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 75 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 76 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

77 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 78 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 79 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 80 81 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 82 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 83 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 84 85 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

90 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 91 Department of Archives and History shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 92 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 93 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 94 Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 95 96 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 97 98 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process. 99

100 SECTION 5. The Mississippi Department of Archives and 101 History is hereby authorized to accept and expend any grant, donation or contribution from any individual, public or private 102 103 organization, or government entity for purposes of defraying the 104 operational costs of the department. Such grants, donations or 105 contributions shall be received and expended under the rules and 106 regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in a 107 manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 6. It is the intent of the Legislature that the Mississippi Department of Archives and History shall charge the maximum amount allowable for services rendered, consistent with the cost of providing such services. The funds derived from these charges shall be deposited into a special fund account in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Department of Archives and History.

115 **SECTION 7.** It is the intent of the Legislature that no part 116 of the funds herein appropriated shall be required to be used for

117 the payment of rent for the museum and public space in the State 118 Historical Museum, Old Capitol Restoration.

119 SECTION 8. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 120 121 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds from the Local Government Records Fund in the State Treasury to defray the cost 122 123 of such program for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007.....\$ 124 80,516.00. No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

192 **SECTION 9.** Of the funds provided in Section 2, Two Million 193 Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) is provided to the Department of Archives 194 and History from the Mississippi Landmark Grant Fund as created in 195 House Bill No. 1082, Regular Session of 1999, to help support the 196 preservation of Mississippi Landmark Properties.

197 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 198 Department of Archives and History is hereby authorized to accept, 199 budget and expend funds, not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand 200 Dollars (\$500,000.00), from special funds in the State Treasury to 201 the credit of the State Treasury fund created in Section 27-19-56.69(8), Mississippi Code of 1972, for the purpose of 202 203 paying the costs of repair and renovation of the New Capitol, the 204 Old Capitol, the Governor's Mansion, and the War Memorial 205 Building, in accordance with rules and regulations of the 206 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds. 207

208 **SECTION 11.** Of the funds provided under the provisions of 209 this act, One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00) is 210 provided for the purpose of developing, maintaining and operating

211 Beauvoir Shrine, the last home of Jefferson Davis, the only 212 President of the Confederate States of America.

SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 213 214 Executive Director of the Department of Archives and History may 215 authorize increases in any major objects of expenditures in total 216 amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided 217 that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a 218 219 corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be authorized which increase the major object of expenditure 220 221 "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that 222 223 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 224 225 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 226 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 227 228 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 229 made without competitive bids.

230 SECTION 14. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 231 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 232 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 233 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 234 235 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 15. This act shall take effect and be in force from 236 237 and after July 1, 2006.
