4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater, beginning on July 1, 2006.

Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

42 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 43 44 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 45 46 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 47 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 48 49 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 50 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 51 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 52 act. 53 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 54 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal

Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 55 56 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 57 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 58 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 59 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 60 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 61 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 62 63 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

64 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 65 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 66 67 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 68 The 69 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 70 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 71 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 72 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

77 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 78 State Fire Academy shall maintain complete accounting and 79 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 80 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 81 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 82 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to 83 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 84 85 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 86 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

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87 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 88 State Fire Academy shall have the authority to escalate and expend 89 funds, not to exceed One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars 90 (\$150,000.00), from any source that may become available to the 91 agency in accordance with the rules and regulations of the 92 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent 93 with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 94 95 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 96 97 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 98 99 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 100 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 101 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

108 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 109 and after July 1, 2006.

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
