## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

## House Bill No. 1580

## **BY: Committee**

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

| 6  | SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be         |
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| 7  | necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State    |
| 8  | Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Nursing   |
| 9  | Home Administrators for the purpose of defraying the expenses of   |
| 10 | the board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending   |
| 11 | June 30, 2007 \$ 139,669.00.                                       |
| 12 | SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions        |
| 13 | of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:              |
| 14 | AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:  |
| 15 | Permanent: Full Time 1   |
| 16 | Part Time 1  |
| 17 | Time-Limited: Full Time  |
| 18 | Part Time0   |
| 19 | Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation      |
| 20 | Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase |
| 21 | equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation    |
| 22 | Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater, |
| 23 | beginning on July 1, 2006.   |

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Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel
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    Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds
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    available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006
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    agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result
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    in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another
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    employee within the same agency, with the same job classification
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    series and greater longevity.
         With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
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    the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
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    make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
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    Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007
    funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
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    are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the
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    Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
    Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
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    determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
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    appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
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          It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
    that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
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    cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal
    Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds.
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    If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal
    Services, " the State Personnel Board determines that the agency
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    has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this
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    projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services"
    appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
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    reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
    requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
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    such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
         Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
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    the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
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    allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
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- 56 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 57 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 58 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 59 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 60 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 61 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 63 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 64 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 65 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 66 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 67 Mississippi State Board of Nursing Home Administrators shall
- 68 maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 69 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 70 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 71 maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of
- 72 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 73 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 74 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 75 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request
- 76 process.
- 77 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 78 Mississippi State Board of Nursing Home Administrators deposit all
- 79 revenue generated into a special fund in the State Treasury to the
- 80 credit of the Mississippi State Board of Nursing Home
- 81 Administrators and that all interest earned or deposited to the
- 82 fund shall remain in the fund and not be paid into the State
- 83 General Fund of Mississippi.
- 84 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 85 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 86 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 87 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

- 88 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 89 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 90 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 91 made without competitive bids.
- 92 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 93 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 94 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 95 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 96 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 97 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 98 **SECTION 7.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 99 and after July 1, 2006.
