## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill No. 1581

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

б	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Physical
9	Therapy, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
10	Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy for the fiscal year
11	beginning July 1, 2006, and ending June 30, 2007
12	\$ 233,642.00.
13	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
14	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
15	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
16	Permanent: Full Time 2
17	Part Time 1
18	Time-Limited: Full Time
19	Part Time 0
20	Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation
21	Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase
22	equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation
23	Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater,
24	beginning on July 1, 2006.

Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 32 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 33 34 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 35 Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 36 37 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 38 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 39 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 40 41 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 42 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 43 44 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 45 46 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 47 48 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 49 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 50 51 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 52 53 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State

57 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 58 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 59 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 60 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 61 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 62 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

67 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy shall maintain 68 69 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 70 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 71 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of 72 73 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 74 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 75 76 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request 77 process.

78 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 79 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 80 81 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 82 83 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 84 made without competitive bids. 85

86 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 87 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 88 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 89 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 90 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 91 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 92 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 93 and after July 1, 2006.
