## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill No. 1582

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 8 9 Treasury to the credit of the Administrative Expense Account of 10 the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose of defraying the administrative expenses of the Board of Trustees of 11 the Public Employees' Retirement System, or out of any money in 12 the State Treasury to the credit of the Retirement System Building 13 Account of the Public Employees' Retirement System for the purpose 14 of maintenance and general operation of the Retirement System 15 Building, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, and ending 16 17 June 30, 2007.....\$ 9,592,171.00. **SECTION 2.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 18 19 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be 20 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 21 expenditure: MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 22 23 Personal Services: 24 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits.. \$ 6,561,864.00

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater, beginning on July 1, 2006.

Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

50 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 51 52 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 53 54 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the 55 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 56 57 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall

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58 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 59 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 60 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 61 62 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal 63 Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 64 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 65 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 66 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 67 68 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 69 70 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 71 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

72 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 73 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 74 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 75 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 76 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The 77 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 78 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 79 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level. 80

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

85 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 86 Board of Trustees of the Public Employees' Retirement System shall 87 maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the 88 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 89 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as

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90 maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of 91 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 92 2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 93 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level 94 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request 95 process.

SECTION 4. In accordance with the purposes of this article, 96 97 there shall be established in the State Treasury the Public Employees' Retirement System Building Repair and Maintenance Fund, 98 99 into which shall be deposited all funds collected as rental income 100 from the building owned by the system located at 301 North President Street, Jackson, Mississippi. At the end of each fiscal 101 102 year, any and all unexpended funds shall be transferred to the 103 Administrative Budget Fund of the system.

104 It is the intention of the Legislature that the system have 105 the authority to escalate the Public Employees' Retirement System 106 Building Repair and Maintenance Fund in an amount not to exceed 107 Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) for repair and 108 maintenance of the buildings owned by the system. All 109 expenditures from the Public Employees' Retirement System Building Repair and Maintenance Fund shall be in accordance with this 110 111 article and for the purposes designated herein.

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 112 113 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 114 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 115 116 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 117 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 118 made without competitive bids. 119

120 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 121 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 122 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 123 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 124 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 125 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 126 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 127 and after July 1, 2006.
