Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be

11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of

Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater, beginning on July 1, 2006.

Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

43 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 44 45 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 46 47 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 48 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 49 50 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 51 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 52 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 53 act. 54 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 55 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal

Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 56 57 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 58 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 59 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 60 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 61 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 62 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 63 64 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

65 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 67 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 68 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 69 The 70 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 71 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 72 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 73 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

78 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 79 Mississippi Board of Nursing shall maintain complete accounting 80 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 81 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 82 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 83 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be submitted to 84 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 85 86 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 87 during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

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SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 88 89 Executive Director of the Mississippi Board of Nursing may authorize increases in major objects of expenditure in total 90 91 amounts not to exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the 92 appropriated amount of each major object of expenditure, provided 93 that other major objects of expenditure are decreased by a corresponding dollar amount. However, no transfers shall be 94 authorized which increase the major object of expenditure 95 96 "Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits."

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 97 98 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 99 100 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 101 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 102 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 103 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 104 made without competitive bids.

105 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 106 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 107 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 108 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 109 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 110 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 111 112 and after July 1, 2006.

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
