## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

## House Bill No. 1598

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be		
6	necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for expenditure out

9	purpose of defraying the expenses of the authority for the fiscal

12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of		
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be		
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of		
15	expenditure:

32	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in a	accordance with	
33	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.		
34	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be		
35	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are		
36	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this		
37	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.		
38	SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the		
39	Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport shall maintain		
40	complete accounting and personnel records related to the		
41	expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such		
42	records shall be in the same format and level of detail as		
43	maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of		
44	the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year		
45	2008 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Bud	dget Committee	
46	in a format and level of detail comparable to the fo	ormat and level	
47	of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request		
48	process.		
49	SECTION 4. In the event of a natural disaster	or other major	
50	catastrophe whereby the expenditure of funds above t	the limits	
51	contained herein are deemed necessary to rapidly rep	pair or restore	
52	port facilities, the Port Authority and the Mississi	ippi	
53	Development Authority, with the approval of the Department	artment of	
54	Finance and Administration, may escalate expenditure	es under	
55	Section 1 and the major objects contained in Section	n 2. However,	

- 56 no escalation shall be authorized until source and availability of
- 57 such funds is shown.
- 58 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 59 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport is hereby authorized
- 60 to escalate and expend funds from any source in accordance with
- 61 applicable rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
- 62 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
- 63 federal funds.
- 64 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 65 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 66 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 67 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 68 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 69 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 70 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 71 made without competitive bids.
- 72 **SECTION 7.** The money appropriated under the provisions of
- 73 Section 1 shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper
- 74 person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 75 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 76 and after July 1, 2006.
