Funds are provided herein to adjust the Variable Compensation Plan to ensure that all full-time employees receive a pay increase equal to the realignment component of the Variable Compensation Plan or Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00), whichever is greater, beginning on July 1, 2006.

Pursuant to policies established by the State Personnel Board, agency heads may, on a case by case basis and within funds available, recommend equity salary adjustments to Fiscal Year 2006 agency appropriation acts where application of limitations result in awarding one employee a salary increase greater than another employee within the same agency, with the same job classification series and greater longevity.

43 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 44 45 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2008 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2007 46 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 47 48 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2008 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 49 50 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 51 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 52 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 53 act. 54 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 55 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation for "Personal

Services" when annualized, with the exception of escalated funds. 56 57 If, at the time the agency takes any action to change "Personal 58 Services," the State Personnel Board determines that the agency 59 has taken an action which would cause the agency to exceed this 60 projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2007 "Personal Services" 61 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 62 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 63 64 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

65 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 66 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or 67 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 68 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 69 The 70 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 71 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 72 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 73 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

78 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 79 Mississippi Real Estate Commission shall maintain complete 80 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 81 82 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2006. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 83 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2008 shall be 84 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 85 86 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 87 provided during the Fiscal Year 2007 budget request process.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 88 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 89 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 90 91 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 92 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 93 94 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 95 made without competitive bids.

96 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 97 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 98 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 99 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 100 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 101 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 102 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from

103 and after July 1, 2006.
