# Adopted AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

## Senate Bill No. 2701

## **BY: Senator(s) Robertson**

### 1 AMEND by inserting the following after line 207 and renumber 2 subsequent sections accordingly:

3 SECTION \*. Section 37-29-101, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
4 amended as follows:

5 37-29-101. In addition to other authority granted by 6 Sections 37-29-1 through 37-29-273 or existing laws, the board of 7 trustees may borrow money in anticipation of taxes, not to exceed fifty percent (50%) of the previous year's ad valorem tax 8 receipts, for the purpose of paying any expenses authorized by law 9 for the operation, maintenance and support of the college. 10 The loan shall be evidenced by note or notes bearing the signatures of 11 12 the chairman of the board and of the secretary of the board of trustees, and the seal of the college shall be thereon impressed. 13 The notes shall mature not later than the thirtieth day of June 14 next thereafter, and the notes shall not bear interest in excess 15 of that allowed in Section 75-17-105, Mississippi Code of 1972. 16 17 (2) The board of trustees may borrow funds from the United 18 States federal government or any agency thereof to compensate for 19 the loss of revenue collected or estimated to be collected on behalf of the community or junior college district from local 20 21 sources during a fiscal year as a result of Hurricane Katrina, may issue its promissory note to the United States federal government 2.2 23 or any agency thereof, and may comply with and issue the

24 regulations of the United States federal government or agency

25 thereof regarding the promissory note. However, this section does

26 not authorize any levy of taxes or pledge of collateral for the

27 security of a promissory note not otherwise allowed by law. The

28 <u>State of Mississippi may sign any promissory note as an equal</u>

29 co-obligor on any such note, and in the event the State of

30 Mississippi signs the promissory note as a co-obligor, the full

31 faith and credit of the State of Mississippi shall be pledged for

32 the payment of the promissory note.

33 SECTION \*. The University of Southern Mississippi, with the 34 approval of the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, is hereby granted the legal authority to borrow funds 35 36 for the limited purpose of repairing damage related to Hurricane The funds may be used for design fees, construction 37 Katrina. 38 costs, furniture and equipment replacement and all other expenses related to repairs or replacement of facilities necessitated by 39 40 Hurricane Katrina.

#### 41 FURTHER amend line 5 of the title by placing the following 42 after the semicolon:

43 TO AMEND SECTION 37-29-101, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE 44 THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF COMMUNITY OR JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICTS TO BORROW FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT TO COMPENSATE FOR 45 46 THE LOSS OF REVENUE COLLECTED OR ESTIMATED TO BE COLLECTED ON 47 BEHALF OF THE JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT DURING A FISCAL YEAR AS A 48 RESULT OF HURRICANE KATRINA; TO AUTHORIZE THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN MISSISSIPPI, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES 49 50 OF STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING, IS HEREBY GRANTED THE 51 LEGAL AUTHORITY TO BORROW FUNDS FOR THE LIMITED PURPOSE OF 52 REPAIRING DAMAGE RELATED TO HURRICANE KATRINA;
