HOUSE BILL NO. 16

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF TUNICA
2 COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO CONTRIBUTE FUNDS TO THE MID-STATE
3 OPPORTUNITY, INC., THE INSTITUTE OF COMMUNITY SERVICES, INC., THE
4 AARON E. HENRY COMMUNITY HEALTH CLINIC, INCORPORATED, AND THE
5 G.A. STOVER HEALTH CLINIC, P.A.; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Board of Supervisors of Tunica County,
8 Mississippi, in its discretion, is authorized to contribute, from
9 any available funds of the county, an amount not to exceed One
10 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) to the Institute of
11 Community Services, Incorporated, during calendar year 2006, and
12 an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00)
13 to the Institute of Community Services, Incorporated, during
14 calendar year 2007, to assist the institute in operating its
15 Headstart classes for three-year-old children in Tunica County, to
16 purchase additional vehicles used to transport children to and
17 from Headstart, and to provide daycare vouchers to parents of
18 Headstart students.

19 (2) The Board of Supervisors of Tunica County, Mississippi,
20 in its discretion, is authorized to contract with or contribute
21 during county fiscal year 2007, an amount not to exceed Four
22 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) to Mid-State
23 Opportunity, Incorporated, for operation of its various programs
24 in and for Tunica County, Mississippi.

25 (3) The Board of Supervisors of Tunica County, Mississippi,
26 in its discretion, is authorized to contribute during calendar
27 year 2006, out of any available funds, an amount not to exceed
28 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to the Aaron E. Henry

29 Community Health Clinic, Incorporated, and an amount not to exceed
30 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to the G.A. Stover
31 Health Clinic, P.A., solely for the purpose of enhancing medical
32 care in and for the residents of Tunica County, Mississippi.

33 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
34 and after its passage.
