The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of 8 9 Finance and Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building, 10 Grounds and Real Property Management, for the purpose of authorizing the expenditure of funds for construction, repair, 11 renovation, furnishings and equipment for the Sillers/Justice 12 Block project, for the period beginning upon passage of this act 13 and through June 30, 2007.....\$ 2,500,000.00. 14 The funds appropriated in this section are provided for the 15 16 purpose of funding the construction and renovation of executive 17 offices for the Attorney General at the Walter Sillers Building, including the purchase of furnishings and equipment. 18 19 SECTION 2. The Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management of the Department of Finance and Administration is 20 21 hereby expressly authorized and empowered to receive, budget and

Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
